Procedure for Studio Application and Fee Payment

1. Read Clayworks Studio Policies – found online under studio membership.
2. Email your completed: * **Clayworks Studio Membership Assessment form.** (to: brantfordpottersguild@gmail.com Attention: Studio Membership).
3. Upon receipt of your application, you will be scheduled for an interview with the Studio Manager. At that time you will be asked to demonstrate your knowledge of how a multi-user pottery studio operates (safety, equipment, cleaning, glazing, ware handling, etc.). You will be asked to bring your portfolio and/or pieces of your work.

4. Once you are accepted by the Studio Manager, you must complete in FULL:

Note: The Annual Studio Membership runs from October 1st to September 30th of the following year. The Full Annual Studio Membership Fee is \$310.00.

A Covid discount rate of \$235.00 is available to studio members who were not able to access the studio due to closures this year.

When you apply for studio membership after September 30th the following rates apply.

October 1st to December 31: \$310.00 (Full Fee)

January 1st to April 30th: \$225.00.

May 1st to September 30th: \$150.00.

5. The payment amount will be confirmed by the studio manager at the time of your interview. Once payment is received/confirmed, you will be given a code for the studio entry door.
